100% Barbera produced on the area of Nizza Montfereato, aging 6 to 9 months in large barrel. It presents itself brightly with a deep ruby colour and respectable variety of aroma with a hint of vanilla, cherries and plum. The impact in the mouth is not powerful but energetic, while the flavour opens with a surprising finesse.

Bin 740 VONDELING "Erica" Shiraz, Paarl, South Africa 2014

Rich red deep purple colour. The wine has an opulent nose of juicy plum and sweet blackcurrants with hints of spices cloves, nutmeg and coriander seeds. The palate is very well weighted, oak brings his own spiciness with plenty of black pepper and good fine tannin. The wine has full, viscous texture and an ultra-long velvety finish.

A top class growers 100% Chardonnay Champagne. Fine and elegant, ideal as an aperitif.

Bin 011 AYALA Brut Majeur NV £95.50

Pale gold in colour with a fine mousse Ayala Brut Majeur NV Champagne is aromatic on the nose. On the palate it is well balanced and shows great finesse and complexity.

Bin 012 DEVAUX Grande Réserve NV £100.00

The must-try champagne from the Classic range with its aromas of ripe fruit, you will be charmed by the Grande Réserve.

Bin 013 DEUTZ CLASSIC Brut NV £118.00

The most "classical" of the Deutz cuvees is far from mundane. The three different champagne grapes are blended in equal and unchanging proportions, ensuring it shows perfect harmony. Its golden color scintillates in the glass, with a fine stream of bubbles rising gracefully to the surface.

Bin 014 BOLLINGER Spcial Cuvée NV £143.00

Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne with great elegance and structure.

Bin 015 CHARLES HEIDSIECK Brut Réserve NV £145.00

Experience a fully developed wine, with a radiant bouquet that is captivating yet subtle. Although notes of fully ripe fruit, such as nectarines and cherry plums, are apparent initially, the finish reveals the wealth of the gourmet world, hinting at nougat, honey and cereal grains.

Bin 016 LOUIS ROEDERER Brut Premier NV £152.00

The embodiment of Louis Roederer style, combining all the fruitiness and freshness of youth with the vinosity of a fully mature wine. An elegantly mature wine, with a lively attack and a smooth palate.

Asolo Spumante is soft, scented and grapey, with delicious lightness and a long lasting 'mousse'.

Bin 050 ALBERT ROUX (LENOBLE) Rosé, Champagne, France NV

£100.00

A unique Rose Champagne that combines elegance with richness of red fruit aromas, superb on its own or with food.

Bin 051 BOLLINGER NV

£170.00

Bollinger Rosé is a particularly fine, fruity & full-flavoured pinky, and like all Bollinger champagnes it's oozing class from every bubble. A fabulous fizz.

Bin 052 LAURENT-PERRIER Brut NV

Bin 100 **DOMAINE LEON BEYER, Pinot Blanc** 2015 £38.00

Youthful and vibrant with plenty of orchard fruit, crisp and dry; the perfect companion for most fish dishes.

Bin 101 **HUGEL & FILS, Riesling cuvée des “Evêques”** 2015 £56.00

Fresh and precise aromatics of Apples, Stone Fruits with little Citrus and Gooseberry. Vivid acidity and Floral Notes.

Bin 102 **HUGEL & FILS, Gewurztraminer cuvée des “Evêques”** 2013 £56.00

Fantastic wine parading blossom Jasmin and lychee fruit characters.

LOIRE, FRANCE

Bin 110 **ALAIN GIRARD, Sancerre** 2017 £50.00

Sauvignon Blanc from a highly regarded producer, classic gooseberry and grassy notes with fresh fruit and a racy acidity.

Bin 112 **LANGLOIS CHATEAU, Pouilly-Fumé** 2016/2017 £50.00

Pale yellow with green reflects, fresh and intense nose and citrus, fruits, almond, fruity taste with a note of gunflint

Bin 113 **SANCERRE “Les Culs de Beaujeu” François Cotat** 2013 £110.00

François essentially runs an organic domaine, tending and harvesting his vines by hand. Harvest is never rushed; in fact, he (as does his cousin Pascal) harvests more than a week after every other winery in the region. Needless to say, extra maturity on the vine means extra body and complexity in the wine

BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Bin 120 **DOMAINE LAROCHE Chablis “St Martin”** 2016 £53.00

Intense lemon citrus and white peach is balanced with a depth of minerality, simply superb!

Bin 122 **DOMAINE LAROCHE Chablis Grand Cru “Les Blanchots”** 2011 £193.00

The wine has complex aroma of citrus with chalky minerality. Grape ripeness was achieved, without any excess of weight or overripe aroma. Finish on the palate is always long, pungent and mineral.

Bin 123	DOMAINE CHEVALIER Ladoix Blanc "Bois de Mont"	2013	£99.00

	<i>Fresh, aromatic and on the palate; fine, juicy, ripe yellow plum and greengage, some fat but not too much. A lovely wine, pretty with a lively fruit-driven finish</i>		

Bin 152 CHÂTEAU MONT REDON, Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2015 £74.00

Châteauneuf-du-Pape is attractive wine if you are looking for the wines to be fragrant, fruity and elegant. Lovers of more mature white wines should wait another five years or more until our wines develop their secondary aromas: honey, white truffle and reminiscent of acacia.

Bin 153 ANDRÉ PERRET, Condrieu 2013 £115.00

An altogether more powerful, unctuous wine than the regular Condrieu that also boasts an extra dimension with its deep, mouth-watering minerality. A Condrieu not for the faint hearted, with impressive flavours of sea salt, peach skin, dried violets nectarine, acacia and fruit stone, multi-layered and persistent.

Bin 154 DOMAINE DU COLOMBIER Blanc, Hermitage 2010 £180.00

Clear, bright and powerful, this is a distinct step up from the domaine's Crozes whites, one of the great whites of the Northern Rhône, showing real class with its melt-in-the-mouth texture, bright fresh citrus peel acids, mineral and limestone complexity and ripe juicy grapefruit, nectarine, peach and Mirabelle fruit.

PROVENCE, FRANCE

Bin 160 DOMAINE GAVOTY Cuvée Clarendon, Provence 2014 £62.00

The Rolle is exclusively used in Provence. You will find a complex nose of pear and grapefruit, melted with a touch of honey and white flowers. The palate is structured, with the pear and floral notes coming forward, and a fresh and long finish

Bin 161 VILLA BAULIEU Blanc Côteaux d'Aix en Provence 2012 £120.00

Bright with tinges of pale green. The nose is characteristically Mediterranean with aromas of ginger, citrus and white peaches. Rich and concentrated, the wine is well balanced with a beautiful texture. Integrated oak and subtle minerality result in an expressive, complex wine.

LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON, FRANCE

Bin 170 LES VIGNES DE M. ROUX & M. CHAPOUTIER, Côtes du Roussillon 2017 £43.00

Fine aromas of apricot, pear and marmalade, a well-balanced food friendly wine.

Bin 171 CAVE DE L'ORMARINE Picpoul de Pinet "Jadix" 2016/2017 £30.00

Exuberantly fresh on the palate with ripe mango fruit, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality.

Bin 172 CLOS DE FÉES, Grenache Blanc, VdP des Côtes de Catalanes 2012 £70.00

This rich and powerful wine has an amazing impression of sweetness, even though it is dry.

Bin 173 LE SOULA, VdP des Côtes de Catalanes 2011 £73.00

This blend of eight grape varieties creates a fantastic wine with great refinement and gorgeous complexity.

ITALY

Bin 190 GAVI DI GAVI DOCG Olim Bauda, Piedmont 2017 £44.00

Straw yellow colour with good intensity and attractive green reflections. The nose is intense with floral notes and ripe citrus. The taste is soft, lively and persistent.

Bin 191 PINOT GRIGIO, San Simone, Friuli 2017 £47.00

Distinctly marked bouquet. Reminiscent of acacia flowers. The taste is dry, fresh, round, pleasantly bitterish, with a notable hint of Artemisia.

Bin 192 PIEROPAN Soave Classico, Veneto 2017 £45.00

Straw yellow with brilliant, greenish and golden reflections, the bouquet is fresh, ample & floral with notes of elderberry, apple, pear & lemon verbena on a background of almonds and nuts; fresh, elegant & well balanced on the palate, with a long finish.

Bin 193 TERRAZZE DELL'ETNA Ciuri Bianco, Sicily 2013/2015 £62.00

Light straw yellow in colour with great clarity and green reflections. Fresh and fragrant with notes of tropical fruit and a hint of rosemary. On the palate it is fresh, well balanced with an acidic backbone and attractive mineral finish.

Bin 194 FRANZ HAAS Gewürztraminer, Alto Adige 2015 £73.00

An intense golden colour with a deep bouquet of complex fragrances such as lychees and orange peel, cloves, nutmeg and roses. Good structure and freshness make a vibrant wine with a lingering aftertaste of subtle bitter almonds.

Bin 195 BELLAVISTA "Vigna Uccellanda", Curtefranca 2010 /2011 £135.00

Well balanced with hints of golden delicious apples, quince and ripe fruit. The taste is full of elegance, smoothness and structure. Very persistent and with an aromatic quality reminiscent of quality silk fabrics.

SPAIN

Bin 200 OSSIAN QUINTALUNA Verdejo, Rueda 2016 £38.00

A wine of huge personality, ripe fruit, balanced with extreme finesse and old vine minerality that ages beautifully.

Bin 201 MAS LA MOLA Priorat Blanco, Cataluna 2012 £84.00

Bright, clear golden yellow, this wine is intense on the nose with notes of ripe yellow stone fruits, an elegant flint character and a hint of white pepper. On the palate it is full bodied and powerful, with fresh acidity and subtle oak notes.

SOUTH AFRICA

Bin 210 VONDELING “Babiana”, Paarl 2016 £40.00

A blend of Chenin Blanc, Viognier & Chardonnay makes a wine with steely minerality and crisp apple flavours

Bin 211 SANGOMA Chenin Blanc, Riebeek Valley, Western Cape 2016 £35.00

Pale lemon in colour with green hints. Perfumes are of fresh, crisp apples, with a touch of pineapple and freshly cut hay. On the palate it is fresh and dry, with orchard fruit offset by ripe, tropical flavours. Clean and dry on the finish.

Bin 212 KLEIN CONSTANTIA Sauvignon Blanc, Constantia, C.R. 2016/2017 £43.00

Bright and light in colour, aromas of white peach and berries fill the nose. The fruit flavours follow through onto the full and expressive palate with an intense long finish, showcasing the typical Klein Constantia minerality.

Bin 213 GLEN CARLOU Chardonnay, Paarl, C.R. 2014 £50.00

Vibrant pale yellow with slight lime green hue. Intense aroma with a complex bouquet of lime-tree and gooseberry, peach and citrus.

ARGENTINA & CHILE

Bin 220 MONTES ALPHA Chardonnay, Casablanca, Chile 2014 £49.00

Very distinguished golden colour. The nose offers outstanding notes of ripe tropical fruits, “golden berries,” bananas, peaches, apricots and grapefruit, along with the asparagus notes that are characteristic of Chardonnay from Casablanca.

Bin 221 KAIKEN Chardonnay, Ultra Mendoza, Argentina 2014 £50.00

Chardonnay shows a golden color with greenish tones in their scents can feel tropical fruits like pineapple, ripe peach, accompanied with an elegant touch of vanilla from aging in French oak barrels.

NEW ZEALAND

Bin 230 TINPOT HUT Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 2017 £46.00

A complex and elegant wine with classic characters of blackcurrant bud and fresh cut thyme.

Bin 231 ATA RANGI Sauvignon Blanc, Martinborough 2017 £55.00

A very complex, structured wine, beautifully perfumed and showing sweet exotic spices, notes of star anise, crushed red rose, violets and ripe, dark berry fruits.

Bin 232 TRINITY HILL Chardonnay Gimblett Gravels, Hawkes Bay 2014/2015 £65.00

Typically fresh aromatics of quality Hawkes Bay Chardonnay are evident including citrus, white flowers and stone fruit.

AUSTRALIA

Bin 240 PETER LEHMANN Sémillon, Barossa Valley 2009 £54.00

The colour is pale gold with a green tinge giving the impression that the wine is younger than it is. The bouquet shows hints of lemon flower together with some waxy, honeyed development so typical of great, aged Sémillon.

Bin 241 VOYAGER ESTATE Sauvignon Blanc/Sémillon, Margaret River 2013/2014 £59.00

Refreshing, crisp, classically Margaret River in style, the Semillon adds a richness and complexity to the fresh Sauvignon Blanc.

Bin 242 VOYAGER ESTATE Chardonnay, Margaret River 2013 £71.00

100% Barrel fermented and matured in French oak. Textured and complex with a subtle nuttiness.

RED WINE

LOIRE, FRANCE

Bin 500 CHÂTEAU DU HUREAU Saumur Champigny “Tuffe” 2015 £37.00

Ripe, juicy and bursting with velvety redcurrant and bramble fruit, gentle acidity on the palate and notes of sweet earth, smoke and cherry towards the finish.

Bin 501 DOMAINE DE LA BUTTE Bourgueil “Le haut de la Butte” 2015 £61.00

These are sensational small production red wines and are some of the most sensual Cabernet Francs in the world.

BURGUNDY

Bin 520 ERIC DE SUREMAIN Rully “les Preaux” 1er Cru 2014 £75.00

Elegant but floral and fresh. Juicy red cherry, strawberry and sweet damson fruit with soft but fortifying tannins. Beautifully focused and delicate.

Bin 521 DOMAINE MEO CAMUZET Fixin 2015 £105.00

Two characteristics dominate this wine: it is extremely soft and extremely easy-drinking. It's less exuberant on the nose than the Marsannay, but more velvety on the palate, silkier and, believe it or not, very long.

Bin 522 DOMAINE CHANSON Beaune-Grèves 1er Cru 2010 £117.00

Bright ruby colour. Subtle floral fragrances mixed with aromas of red berries and spices. Subtle vanilla note. Generous with a tight texture. Well-balanced. Expressive tannins on a well integrated oak. Refreshing and fruit aftertaste.

Bin 523 ROBERT CHEVILLON Nuit-St-Georges Vieilles Vignes 2012 £118.00

Round, silky ripe cherry, summer berry and loganberry, some sweet touches of griotte and oak spice. Soft, lacy and long. A Nuits Premier Cru vineyard on the Vosne side of the appellation and thus usually one of the silkier wines of the Cheillon cellar.

Bin 524 DROUHIN LAROZE Gevrey-Chambertin 2014 £126.00

Unbelievable spiced fruit and sous bois on the nose. Very ripe, great depth of fruit, still very fresh with great balancing acidity and a very long finish, simply stunning!

Bin 525 DOMAINE CHANSON Beaune 1er Cru “Le Clos des Mouches” 2010 £163.00

Dark ruby colour. Intense aromas of raspberry and cherry blossom with a hint of cocoa and an array of spices. Complex, refined and well-balanced. Beautiful texture. Harmonious oak note and fine grained tannins. Good persistence with a touch of cocoa at the end.

Bin 526 JEAN GRIVOT Chambolle Musigny “La Combe d'Orveaux” 2011/2013 £175.00

Bright, fresh and airy. Intense vibrant and racy red fruits of redcurrant and cranberry with hints of cassis and rock salt. Silky, taut and lively.

Bin 527 JEAN GRIVOT Vosne Romanée 2013 £184.00

From a premier cru which sits high on the slope. It is no more than medium-bodied but the class shows in its exceptional perfume. A fine Vosne for lovers of true elegance.

Bin 528 FRANCOIS LAMARCHE Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru 2011 £330.00

The heightened fruit and perfume of this wine make it very stylish indeed. It has real weight behind with excellent acidity and a fine, long finish.

Bin 529 FRANCOIS LAMARCHE Echezeaux Grand Cru 2010 £419.00

The ultimate in finesse – sumptuous, long, ripe flavours with vitality in abundance, fantastic fruit characteristics of wild strawberry, Victoria plum, redcurrant and cherry blossom clasped gently by satin-textured tannins. Glorious.

Bin 530 DOMAINE DE CHANSON Chambertin-Clos de Bèze Grand Cru 2008 £482.00

Dark ruby colour. Intense aromas of black fruit, blackcurrant jam, mixed with underwood notes. Delicate vanilla note. Complex, powerful, generous and well-structured. Very pure fruit and beautiful texture.

This is a well-structured wine that displays aromas of ripe red fruit and sweet baking spices with tones of vanilla, nutmeg and clove that complement the wine's full body and firm yet supple tannins

Bin 551 LES TOURELLES DE LONGUEVILLE Pauillac 2011 £129.00

2nd wine of Château Pichon Longueville Baron. Seductive, with loads of black fruits, an almost caramelized note, low acidity and voluptuous texture.

Bin 552 DOMAINE DE CHEVALIER G.C.C. Pèssac-Léognan 2012 £146.00

Deep and intense color Generous and fresh nose of ripe fruits. Red and black berries mixed with lightly peppery spices. Presence of mineral. Menthol and liquorice.

Bin 553 CHÂTEAU CANTENAC BROWN 3eme C.C. Margaux 2010 £179.00

The freshness of this vintage is remarkable with such naturally high alcohol content. Amazingly, the acid, alcohol, and tannins form a perfect harmony.

Bin 555 CHÂTEAU BRANE CANTENAC 2eme C.C. Margaux 2009 £294.00

Beautifully perfumed Margaux bouquet, this is very pretty with hints of flowers, blackcurrants, bright summer fruits, smoked meats and liquorice.

Bin 556 CHÂTEAU PAPE CLEMENT G.C.C. Pèssac-Léognan 2007 £294.00

An opaque purple colour along with notes of graphite, blueberries, and blackberries, stunning richness, a full-bodied mouthfeel, and tremendous length and intensity.

Bin 557 CHÂTEAU PICHON COMTESSE LALANDE 2eme C.C. Pauillac 2011 £318.00

A really composed Lalande, which has a velvety texture and beautifully managed tannins. A really well crafted, stylish Lalande for the long-term.

Bin 558 CHÂTEAU MONTROSE 2eme C.C. St. Estephe 2008 £334.00

Wine offers a dense purple color followed by gorgeously sweet black raspberry and black currant fruit intermixed with loamy, earthy, forest floor notes, a floral component and a long, full-bodied finish.

Bin 560 CHÂTEAU COS D'ESTOURNEL 2eme C.C St. Estèphe 2006 £403.00

A great rich nose of cherries, tobacco, espresso and damp earth. Terrific density of dusty, cooked red fruits, with some exotic spice.

Bin 561 VIEUX CHATEAU CERTAN Pomerol 2012 £424.00

Initially perfumed, with fragrant floral notes, morello cherries, raspberries and fine herbs. The Merlot plots next to Petrus have produced wonderfully silky, svelte fruit with a cashmere, velvety texture and plushness.

Bin 559 CHÂTEAU LYNCH BAGES 5eme C.C Pauillac 2005 £403.00

Soft red fruits and toasty oak on the nose with sweet delicious flavours of dark fruits, chocolate, mineral, coffee and leather on the palate, with a long velvety finish. Surprisingly youthful.

Bin 562 CHÂTEAU MARGAUX Pavillon Rouge 2005 £446.00

Very deep, smooth and elegant on the nose, with lots of raspberry and cherry fruit and a glycerol edge; very pure and quite tight on the palate, good concentration and a creamy texture, lush red fruit and gripping tannins.

Bin 563 LE PETIT CHEVAL St Emilion 2009 £482.00

There is a beautifully heady nose of confectionary, bright red berries, stony minerality, cherry liqueur, loganberries, graphite and sweet earth. This is wonderfully sleek and refined with wave after wave of cool sweet black fruit.

Sweet seductive silky fruit, ripe griotte, sloe and damson flavours, luscious and fine to a long, true finish.

Bin 582 M. CHAPOUTIER Côte-Rotie "Les Bécasses" 2014 £140.00

Deep red, ample, elegant, very well-structured and balanced.

Bin 583 MONIER DE LA SIZERANNE Hermitage 2012 £168.00

Aromas of black fruit and crushed black and pink peppercorns. Soft, warm and very juicy, evolving into smoke, leather and spice.
